

Job Description Connections Pastor

DESCRIPTION:

In collaboration with the mission and vision of Immanuel Baptist Church, the Connections Pastor will lead guests and members into a genuine sense of belonging, involvement, and spiritual growth at Immanuel Baptist Church. By meeting people where they are and leading them to the next steps, the CP will facilitate relational connection and spiritual growth for all ages through small groups, volunteer teams, and the assimilation of new and perspective members.

The Connections Pastor will be responsible for the following:

1) Small Group Ministry

- Help implement and oversee small group ministry for all age groups within the church
- Recruit, train, and facilitate small group leaders
- Help research and find small group materials and guides as needed

2) Church Community Life

- Fosters and advocates intergenerational fellowship and ministry to all age groups
- Work alongside Senior pastor and ministry teams to lead churchwide community events (i.e., Ice Cream socials, community dinners, etc)
- Responsible for recruiting leaders and participants for said events.
- Help welcome and integrate visitors and less active members into the life of the church

3) Other duties may include:

- Collaborate with CBF Student Fellowship and other campus ministries to help foster relationships with ECU and other area schools
- Assist with social media updates, website edits, and administrative tasks as needed
